For a professional finish, Alsynite recommend you install Skylite using the following accessories:



Noise Stop Tape will reduce the creaking noise made from the natural expansion and contraction of the roof sheeting.



Back Channel Foam will ensure your Skylite roofing sheet is secure inside the Back Channel Flashing.



Eave Infill Strip (Profile Foam) prevents rain, dust and wind entering eaves.



Timbertite Type 17 Fasteners with 21mm EPDM washers are recommended for installing Skylite GRP roofing.

- Complies with AS3566 & the MRM Code of Practice
- Allow 7 fasteners for every lineal metre of sheeting
- Predrill a 10mm hole in the sheeting for installations up to 4.2m
- Predrill a 12mm hole for longer lengths
- Available in packets of 50





INSTALLATION GUIDE

WARNING: DO NOT WALK DIRECTLY ON THE SHEET



- The roof should have a minimum pitch of 5°
- Purlins should be no further than 750mm apart (closer in high wind zones)
- Select the sheet length from the standard lengths available
- Use the *Sheet Coverage table* to calculate the number of sheets required
- Ensure appropriate tools are used to install the sheeting
- Roof sheeting must be fixed with Alsynite 12g x 55mm fasteners
- When used as cladding or fencing use Alsynite Timberite 12g x 25mm fasteners
- Ensure lapping edge faces away from the prevailing wind
- Do not walk directly on the sheets. If access is required, use walking planks.
- Fix at every third corrugation mid span and every second at the ridge and gutter.
